Soaring Unlimited Haiti is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization incorporated in 1994 in the United States, and operating in the Cap Haitien area in Northern Haiti. Soaring Unlimited Haiti has developed initiatives to help address the needs of Haitian people, including access to healthcare, clean water and sanitation, nutrition, housing, and education and training for children, youth, and adults. We employ, partner with, and engage many local Haitians and their organizations, as well as working with a variety of congregations, faith-based organizations, and other nonprofits based in the U.S.

Soaring Unlimited Haiti exists to promote justice in the region and give its people agency over their own lives, with a special focus on the health and well being of the women and children of Northern Haiti.

A New Chapter, Rooted in Community

For more than 30 years, Soaring Unlimited Haiti has walked alongside communities in northern Haiti, building relationships that have endured through political uncertainty, natural disasters, economic hardship, and profound change.

FY2026 was another year of showing up.

Our medical clinic continued providing essential care as displacement placed new pressures on communities in the North. At Sante Fanm, our midwives welcomed new lives into the world and celebrated remarkable maternal health milestones. Students continued their education. Women invested in their businesses and families.

This year also marked a new chapter for Soaring.

In March 2026, Deborah David joined Soaring Unlimited Haiti as Executive Director, building upon the foundation established over more than three decades while helping prepare the organization for its next era. As part of this transition, Rev. Dr. Laura Alexander Elliott moved into the role of Missions Director, continuing her longstanding commitment to Soaring by nurturing the relationships, partnerships, and mission connections that have sustained the organization for more than 30 years.

As a Haitian woman and member of the diaspora, Deborah brings both a personal connection to Haiti and more than two decades of nonprofit and international development leadership.

At Sante Fanm, Soaring's Haitian midwives provide women with skilled, compassionate maternal care in a safe and welcoming environment.

This year brought several extraordinary milestones.

Sante Fanm surpassed 900 babies born since opening and marked 3½ years of operation without a maternal death.

And among this year's smallest arrivals were three very special ones:

Their birth offered a joyful reminder of what Sante Fanm was created to provide: quality maternal care close to home, supported by trained Haitian health professionals.

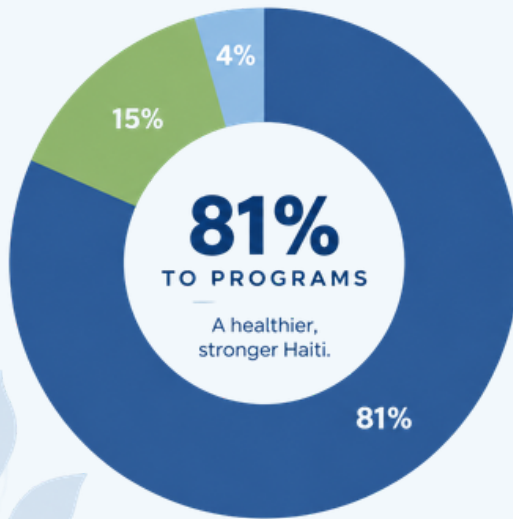
